

SCAN/Connector Application Instructions / Job Description

Style Editor

Description:

The Style Editor is the voice of fashion, beauty and lifestyle for The Connector and SCAN. Applicant should have a strong writing skills and demonstrated interests in style and trends.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be a current SCAD student in good standing. Previous experience with Student Media is desired, but not required.

Deadline:

Completed applications must be e-mailed in .pdf format to editor@scadconnector.com by 5 p.m. on February 26, 2024.

Additional application materials:

Applicants are required to submit at least two writing samples, preferably articles previously published in The Connector, SCAN or other publication, or writing assignments prepared for class. These submissions should illustrate the best work the applicant has done and why they would be best for this position. Applicants should also submit a cover letter describing what they will bring to the job, a résumé, a professional reference, and respond to these short answer questions:

- What do you want to get out of your involvement in Student Media?
- Managing deadlines can be challenging with school. How will you deal with the requirements of your job along with your coursework?
- What qualities of The Connector/SCAN do you like and why?

Interviews:

Interview times will be assigned after applications are turned in.

Job Description

General:

- Report directly to managing editor.
- Plan and assign content of Style section, which covers campus, community, local and nationwide happenings.
- Have good working knowledge of Associated Press style and SCAD style.
- Observe all established deadlines.
- Other duties as assigned by managing editor and editor-in-chief.

Weekly:

- Responsible for publishing three articles a week for the fashion section (may solicit contributors).
- Bring three story pitches to weekly staff meeting.
- Communicate deadlines to contributors.
- Respond to all emails within 24 hours.
- Attend all regular staff and editorial board meetings.

Quarterly:

- Contribute to the production of SCAN Magazine
- Attend two student media events (ex: Hub promos, SCAD Days).
